Abelia engleriana £12.50

A rare species forming a medium sized shrub. Reddish shoots and glossy green leaves. Funnel shaped purple-pink, flowers with an apricot throat in mid summer. Best planted in a sunny, sheltered site and in a well drained soil. Ht 6-8ft (180- 250c

Acer rubrum RED SUNSET 'Franksred' AGM £20.00

A selected form of the 'Canadian Maple/ Red Maple' of upright habit and particularly good, red autumn colouring. Grows best in a lime free soil. Mature Ht 50ft (15m).

Acer 'Warrenred' = Pacific Sunset £22.50

Acer palmatum 'Ao Kanzashi' £17.50

A vase shaped shrub with variegated leaves. Green foliage with greenish white margins turning orange-red in Autumn. Ht 15ft (4.5m). Neutral to acid soil.

Acer carpinifolium £22.50

Deciduous tree of elegant habit, often with several main stems. Prominent veined, hornbeamed like leaves turn golden brown in autumn. Requires full sun and well-drained soil. Ht 9 metres (29ft). Spread 6 metres.

Acer rubrum RED SUNSET 'Franksred' AGM £22.50

A selected form of the 'Canadian Maple/ Red Maple' of upright habit and particularly good, red autumn colouring. Grows best in a lime free soil. Mature Ht 50ft (15m).

Acer cissifolium £32.50

A small tree with trifoliolate, bronze tinted leaves which turn red and yellow in autumn, branches grey and smooth, bark dotted with red. Similar to *Acer henryi* but margins of the leaflets are coarsely toothed. Prefers an acid soil. May reach 20-30ft (6-9m).

Acer rubrum RED SUNSET 'Franksred' AGM £20.00

A selected form of the 'Canadian Maple/ Red Maple' of upright habit and particularly good, red autumn colouring. Grows best in a lime free soil. Mature Ht 50ft (15m).

Acer rubrum 'October Glory' AGM £22.50

Red maple. A free-growin,ultimately large tree. An american selection with long-lasting, brilliant red autumn colour. Acid soil. AGM. Mature Ht 40-50ft (12-15m)

Acer rubrum 'Joseph' (Sartori) £21.50

Upright slow growing selection of *Acer rubrum* with a fascinating colouring yellow-gold in autumn, red-ruby colour if cultivated in acidic soils. Ht 10 metres.

Betula pendula 'Golden Beauty' £20.00

A true golden leaved form that is bright and cheerful whose leaves do not scorch. A very promising and recent introduction in 2002. Ht up to 5m/ 16ft in 10 years.

Betula Albosinensis 'Red Panda' AGM £23.00

White peeling bark with age, slightly pendulous branches. Dimond-shaped green leaves turn yellow in Autumn. Matures into 20ft.

Betula Pendula 'Zwisters Glorie' £17.50

A large, deciduous tree with a tidy pyramid shape and small, plentiful foliage. This tree also has the bright white bark that is uniform to it's species. Can grow to a mature height of approx 15m (49ft) and grows best in moist, well-drained soil and part-sun.

Betula pendula 'Golden Beauty' £20.00

A true golden leaved form that is bright and cheerful whose leaves do not scorch. A very promising and recent introduction in 2002. Ht upto 5m/ 16ft in 10 years.

Betula utilis var. jacquemontii 'Silver Shadow' £32.50

A lovely tree with intensely white bark, contrasting with the dark green leaves, which turn a vivid yellow in the Autumn. Bears Catkins in the early spring. Approx 12m (39ft). 20-25 yrs to ultimate height. Best suited to well-drained soil and a sunny position.

Betula Semp. Topiary Pyramid £25.00

'Box'. Small dark green foliage. Slow growing compact habit. Clip into shape. Ideal for a topiary specimen either in ground or in pot / urn. Any reasonable soil, sun / part shade.

Betula Albosinensis 'Red Panda' AGM £22.50

White peeling bark with age, slightly pendulous branches. Dimond-shaped green leaves turn yellow in Autumn. Matures into 20ft.

Buddleja davidii 'Nanho Purple' AGM £7.50

An elegant slender branched form, narrow leaves. Long cylindrical panicles purple fragrant flowers during summer. 5ft height. Requires full sun.

Callistemon Pityoides £17.50

Syn Callistemon sieberi. The hardiest species 'the alpine bottlebrush'. Evergreen, arching shrub. Small bright green leaves. Short spikes of pale yellow flws, Jun-Aug. Ht 3-5ft. Not successful on shallow, chalky soils. Fertile soil, full sun.

Carpinus betulus AGM £25.00

Deciduous, round headed tree. Has a fluted trunk and oval, prominently veined, dark green leaves that turn yellow and orange in autumn. Bears green catkins from late spring to autumn, when clusters of winged nuts appear. Height 15m. Spread 20m

Carpinus turczaninowii AGM £22.50

An attractive small shrubby tree. Slender stems and small leaves. Young leaves are bright red. Hop-like fruit clusters. AGM 2002. Easily grown trees, suitable for chalky or clay soils.

Ceanothus thyrsiflorus 'Millerton Point' £10.00

Low growing mounding ceanothus. Bright green evergreen glossy foliage. Masses of dense clusters of pure white flowers. Flws: May- Jun. Ht 3- 5ft, higher against a wall. A spectacular spring sight. Well drained soil, sun.

Celtis Biondii £22.50

'Korean Hackberry'. Dark green veined foliage. Orange fruits. 4m height after 10 years.

Cercis canadensis 'Pauline Lily' £22.50

A striking form of the 'North American Redbud'. It is a heavy bloomer in spring producing blush pink flowers. Heart shaped leaves turn yellow in autumn. Slow growing. Ht 10ft. Well drained soil. Sunny position.

Chamaecyparis lawsoniana 'Luna' £14.00

A dense, broadly conical tree. Foliage yellow with white tips fading to grey green. 3-4m height after 10 years.

Clethra Alnifolia 'Pink Spires' £25.00

An erect bushy shrub. Glossy serrated bright green leaves. Terminal spires of sweetly fragrant pink bells. Flws: Aug/Oct. Ht 4-5ft. Moist well drained peaty soil. Part shade.

Cornus Amomum 'Lady Jane' £25.00

Compact shrubby habit. Dark green leaves turn warm red colours in autumn. White flws, June. Ht 1.5m (5ft). Any reasonable soil. Will even grow in moist soil.

Cotoneaster mirabilis £10.00

Slightly shiny dark-green leaves on wide-spreading branches. Deciduous or semi-evergreen. Pink flowers bloom May-June followed by crimson-purple fruit from Sept-Oct. Ht; 1.5-2.5m. Prefers well drained soil & a sunny spot. Wind-hardy and good in coastal areas.

Cotoneaster salicifolius £10.00

Vigorous, evergreen, arching shrub. Fully hardy. Has narrowly lance shaped dark green leaves. Small 5 petalled white flowers in early summer, are followed by clusters of small spherical red fruits. Height and spread 5m. Requires full sun and well drained soil.

Cotoneaster Sherriffii £7.50

Dense spreading shrub with mid-green foliage, turning purple in the Autumn and white flowers from May-June. Semi-evergreen. Pale orange fruits ripens Sept - Oct. Ht; ,0.5-2.5m. Wind-hardy and good in coastal areas.

Cotoneaster Turbinatus £10.00

An elegant, large shrubs which flowers with white blooms in July. Evergreen. Deep blue-grey foliage and small, bright scarlet berries which ripen in Oct. Ht; up to 6m. Prefers well drained soil & a sunny spot. Wind-hardy and good in coastal areas.

Cydonia oblonga 'Smyrna' £22.50

One of many interesting obscure varieties. Medium size, pear shaped, heavy cropping. Self Fertile. Large pale green felted foliage producing large pear shaped yellow quinces in Oct, from fragrant pale pink blossom Mar-May. Fruits used in jams and fruit compote. Ht 10ft.

Cotoneaster Kingdonii £10.00

Deciduous. Dark green foliage on erect, arched branches, leaves turn red and purple in Autumn. The deep pink flowers bloom June - July followed by red berries in Oct. Ht; 3-4m. Prefers well drained soil & a sunny spot. Wind-hardy and good in coastal areas.

Cotoneaster Schantungensis £10.00

Dark green foliage on arched branches, blooms from June - July followed by red fruit Oct - Nov. Deciduous. Lovely autumn colouring. Attractive to birds as it holds its fruit well into late autumn. Ht; 1.5-2.5m Prefers well drained soil & a sunny spot. Wind-hardy and good in coastal areas.

Cotoneaster meiphyllus £10.00

Cornus 'Eddie's White Wonder' AGM £30.00

A lovely small tree. 'cornus florida x cornus nuttallii'. Habit taller than C.florida and denser than C.nuttallii. Large white bracts. Flws: May-Jun. Good red autumn colouring. AGM. Fertile, humus rich acid soil, sun part shade.

Callicarpa cathayana £12.50

Deciduous, bushy shrub. Oval leaves with grey pubescence. Tiny star-shaped pinkish-lilac flowers, mid summer. Dense clusters of spherical, soft lilac fruits. Ht 6-8ft. Sun, well drained soil.

Desmodium elegans (syn. tiliifolium) AGM £12.50

Deciduous, upright shrub similar to the Lespedeza. Mid green leaves consist of 3 large leaflets. Large racemes of pale lilac, pea flowers appear from late summer to mid autumn followed by seed pods. AGM 2002. Requires full sun and well drained soil.

Diospyros Kaki £22.50

'Chinese Persimmon'. Large shrub/ small tree. Brilliant autumn colour ranging from orange-reds to plum- purples. Edible, orangey- yellow, tomato-like fruits, late summer. Any reasonable soil. Sheltered position.

Diospyros Lotus £32.50

The 'Date Plum'. A small, hardy tree. Dark green glossy leaves. Purple or yellow, tomato-like fruits are produced on female plants. Fertile soil. Sunny position.

Diospyros hyrcanum £20.00

A selected form. Please help if you know of this plant.

Deutzia Scabra 'Plena' £7.50

Tall, erect branched shrub. Ht 3 metres. Clusters of double white suffused rose purple. Flws: June-July. Deciduous. Any reasonable fertile soil.

Eleagnus pungens 'Maculata' £15.00

One of the most popular variegated evergreens. Glossy, dark green leaves with large central, deep yellow patch. Fragrant, urn-shaped, ivory-white flws. Flws, Sept-Oct. Full sun, well drained soil. Ht 5ft.

Eucommia Ulmoides £22.50

'Gutta-percha tree'. Large, leathery, glossy elm-like leaves. Petalless green flws, spring. Winged fruits in female plants. Ht 15-20ft (4.5-6m).The only hardy tree known to produce rubber. Used in Chinese medicine to treat back pain. Any reasonable soil.

Escallonia Iveyi AGM £7.50

Evergreen, upright shrub. Glossy, dark green leaves set off large racemes of small, shallowly fragrant, tubular, pure white flws with short lobes, mid-late summer. AGM. Sun, well drained soil. Ht 6ft.

Escallonia 'Edinensis' £7.50

Evergreen shrub of neat, bushy habit. Small glossy green leaves. Carmine buds open to clear shell pink flowers, late summer to early autumn. Ht 2 metres. Any reasonable soil. Sunny position.

Escallonia illinita £7.50

A tall strong smelling shrub upto 3 metres. Large glossy evergreen leaves. Cylindrical panicles of white flowers, summer-early autumn. Well drained soil. Sunny position.

Escallonia 'Donard Star' £7.50

Evergreen. Medium sized shrub of compact, upright habit. Large leaves and flowers of lovely rose pink, summer-early autumn. Ht 1.5m. Well drained soil. Sunny position.

Escallonia 'Edinensis' £7.50

Evergreen shrub of neat, bushy habit. Small glossy green leaves. Carmine buds open to clear shell pink flowers, late summer to early autumn. Ht 2 metres. Any reasonable soil. Sunny position.

Hoheria sexstylosa 'Crataegifolia' £30.00

Unusual form with small dark green, toothed leaves. Evergreen and upright in habit it will form a large shrub, bearing masses of white flowers in mid-summer. Best on well drained soil in full sun/part shade and given shelter from cold winds.

Hoheria Ace of Spades £17.50

A lovely, quick growing, evergreen small tree. A spectacular sight in late summer when the whole tree is laden with pure white round flowers. Of hybrid origin probably *H. angustifolia* and *H. lyallii*. Happy in most situations sun or shade given reasonable soil and moisture. May need winter protection in coldest localities and the protection of a warm wall.

Hedera helix 'Spetchley' AGM £5.00

Attractive variety. A dense, prostrate and congested form with very small leaves. Good for a rock garden, low wall or tub. Sun or shade. Any reasonable soil.

Hoheria sexstylosa 'Crataegifolia' £30.00

Unusual form with small dark green, toothed leaves. Evergreen and upright in habit it will form a large shrub, bearing masses of white flowers in mid-summer. Best on well drained soil in full sun/part shade and given shelter from cold winds.

Hypericum 'Miracle Fantasy' £7.50

A new improved series of six hypericum prized for their berries and compact habit. Abundant clusters of white berries contrast well with the dark green foliage making both an excellent plant for the patio and for front of the border. Ht and spr 3ft (1m).

Hovenia dulcis £22.50

'Japanese Raisin Tree'. A large shrub/ small tree. Handsome polished foliage. Reddish fruit stalks mature to thick, fleshy stems. They are eaten in India, Japan and China.

Hypericum 'Magical Red' = Kolmred £7.99

Erect growing shrub with ovate leaves. Yellow flowers. Flws: Jun-Sept. Ht 2-3ft. Showy clusters of red and black berries, autumn. Well drained soil, sunny position

Hydrangea Lemon Wave £7.50

Beautiful uniquely marked foliage, colours from green-lemon yellow. Showy blue-pink flws, Jul-Aug.

Ilex Aquif. Bacciflava £30.00

Slow growing large shrub/small tree, glossy dark green, nearly spineless leaves. Heavy crops bright yellow berries, late autumn, early winter. Berries from young plants. Ht 12ft. Most ordinary soils, sun/shade.

Ilex Aquipernyi 'Dragon Lady' £25.00

Ilex x aquipernyi is a cross between I. aquifolium and I. pernyi. 'Meschick', commonly sold under the trade name of DRAGON LADY, is a female cultivar that grows as an upright, symmetrical, very narrow pyramid, eventually maturing to 10-15ft tall and to 4-6ft wide. Spiny, ovate-quadrangular, evergreen, dark green leaves are attractive year round. Scarlet fruits in autumn remain on the plant through winter.

Ilex Aquif. J C Van Tol AGM £20.00

A superb cultivar. Forming a dense pyramidal shape. Dark shining almost spineless glossy green leaves. Self fertile. Large crops red berries. Ht 10ft. Moist loamy soil, sun part shade.

Ilex meserveae BLUE PRINCESS 'Conapri' £15.00

'Blue holly'. The female form with bluish-green leaves and brilliant glossy red berries in winter. Plant with male for berries. Excellent for pot culture. Any reasonably soil. Sun or part shade.

'Blue holly'. The female form with bluish-green leaves and brilliant glossy red berries in winter. Plant with male for berries. Excellent for pot culture. Any reasonably soil. Sun or part shade.

Ilex Aquif. Bacciflava £30.00

Slow growing large shrub/small tree, glossy dark green, nearly spineless leaves. Heavy crops bright yellow berries, late autumn, early winter. Berries from young plants. Ht 12ft. Most ordinary soils, sun/shade.

Laburnocytisus Adamii £20.00

An unusual small tree, a hybrid between laburnum and broom with a variety of drooping panicles of flower yellow/ pink/ purple May/Jun all on the same plant.

Lonicera Alseuosmoides £17.50

Deciduous honeysuckle. Moderate growth rate. Purple flws, with pale yellow inside in mid-summer. Purplish black berries. Sun or part-shade.

Lonicera Ramosissima £15.00

A selected form

Lonicera Caerulea 'Kamschatica' £15.00

Deciduous shrub from north eastern Asia. Glaucons green leaves. Whitish flws, late winter/ early spring followed by dark blue berries. Ht 4-6ft (1.2-1.8m). Any reasonable soil. Sunny position.

Lonicera Caerulea var longifolia £15.00

Lonicera Albertii £12.50

A low growing shrub of spreading habit. Linear, glaucons leaves. Relatively large showy, fragrant, lilac pink flowers, May. Purplish red berries. Ht 3-4ft (90cm-120cm). Any reasonable soil.

Lonicera Nitida 'Lemon Beauty' £6.50

A new variety of shrubby Lonicera. Rounded evergreen small shrub. Attractive variegated, bold lemon and dark green foliage. Ht 2-3ft. Good for hedging. Fully hardy. Any reasonable soil.

Laureliopsis philippiana £20.00

Ligustrum Japonicum 'Texanum' £17.50

A compact, medium sized shrub. Glossy olive green leaves with slight undulating margins. Excellent evergreen for screening or hedging. White flowers, late summer. Any reasonable soil. Shade tolerant. Shelter from cold winds.

Liriodendron Tulipifera 'Heltorf' £30.00

New variety. Beautiful large shrub/small tree. Distinctive large rounded deep grey green foliage. Colouring bright yellow in autumn. Yellow/ green tulip flws. Flws, Jun-Jul. Ht 12ft. Well drained soil, sun/ part shade.

Magnolia Liliiflora Nigra AGM £15.00

Deciduous, upright, compact shrub. Large, deep purple flowers, pale pink or white inside. Dark green leaves from mid-spring to mid-summer. Full sun and well drained soil. Ht 3m. Sprd 3m.

Magnolia Sieboldii £20.00

A large, wide spreading shrub. Nodding, fragrant, white flws with turned out petals. Egg-shaped in bud. Flws: May/Aug. Acid soil. Spectacular crimson fruit. Rich, deep soil. Sun or part shade

Metasequoia Glypt. 'All Bronze' £25.00

Morus Rubra £17.50

Red Mulberry. A rare species. A small tree with rounded, downy leaves turning bright yellow in autumn. Red fruits. Any reasonable well drained soil.

Nandina Domestica 'Richmond' £17.50

'Sacred Bamboo'. One of the best forms for berries. A vigorous form with an abundance of red fruits during the winter. Decorative evergreen bamboo like shrub. Large compound leaves tinged red in spring and autumn. Large terminal panicles white flws, Jul/Aug. Ht 4-6ft. Well drained fertile soil, sun, sheltered position.

Olearia Virgata £12.50

Evergreen, arching, graceful shrub with very narrow, dark grey-green leaves. Produces an abundance of small, star-shaped, white flower heads in early summer, arranged in small clustewrs along stems. Requires full sun and well drained soil. Height 4m. Spread 3.5m.

Olearia Solandri £25.00

Evergreen shrub. Small and narrow, greeny-yellow leaves. Flowering time-summer and autumn-strongly scented. Needs protection in cold areas. Ht.2m.

Olea Europea, spiral stem £45.00

'Olive tree'. Small tree. Grey green, leathery foliage. Small white fragrant flws in late summer. Evergreen. Excellent for pot culture. Ideal on patios or in conservatory.

Picea likiangensis £25.00

This species is found in Bhutan and China. The almost pendent new growth is bright green and highlights the violet cones very well. Foliage matures to dark green while the cones will mature to rich brown.

Pterocarya Stenoptera £25.00

A large vigorous tree native to China, with leaves upto 40cm long. Flowers unisexual, both sexes borne on the same tree but on different catkins. Female catkins 20cms. long, male catkins one third in length. Moisture-loving and requiring deep loamy soil.

Prunus x subhirtella 'Autumnalis' £22.50

An attractive small tree producing masses of semi double white flowers on the bare wood, Nov-March, often producing flowers all winter. Ht 10-12ft, (3metres). Very hardy.

Prunus insititia 'Merryweather Damson' Pixy £19.99

A reliable and heavy cropping damson. Clusters of white blossom in spring, large plum sized blue black damsons in late September. For cooking or dessert. Ht 10ft. Rootstock: Pixy, semi- dwarf. Ht 3-3.5metres in 10 years.

Pterocarya Stenoptera £25.00

A large vigorous tree native to China, with leaves upto 40cm long. Flowers unisexual, both sexes borne on the same tree but on different catkins. Female catkins 20cms. long, male catkins one third in length. Moisture-loving and requiring deep loamy soil.

Pyrus 'Conference' AGM £15.00

A very popular variety of pear producing juicy sweet, hard skinned fruits in late September. A good pollinator, partially self-fertile. Grown on a dwarf rootstock, ideal for growing in a pot on the patio or balcony.

Prunus Lauroc Caucasica £10.00

A vigorous, upright form. Narrower leaves than the type. Evergreen, glossy leaves. Excellent hedging plant. Plant 75cm-1metre apart. Ht 12ft. Any moist soil, part shade.

Prunus Sub. 'Autumnalis' AGM £22.50

An attractive small tree producing masses of semi double white flowers on the bare wood, Nov-March, often producing flowers all winter. Ht 10-12ft, (3metres). Very hardy.

Prunus x subhirtella 'Autumnalis White' £20.50

Small spreading bushy trees highly valued for their long season of flowering from late autumn to April, especially during mild winters. Prunus 'Autumnalis' becomes white when the flowers are fully open. Ht 4m / 13ft.

Prunus padus £20.00

'Bird Cherry'. Deciduous, spreading tree conical when young. Bears fragrant, white flowers in pendent spikes, May, followed by small, black fruits, late summer. Dark green leaves turn yellow in autumn. Sun & well drained soil. Ht 15-20ft.

Picea pungens 'Waldbrunn' £17.50

A spherical, low spreading mound with long dark grey blue needles. Ht 25cm x spr 30cm.

Picea glauca 'Julian Potts Montrosa' £22.50

Prinspepia sinensis £8.00

A rare shrub. Producing arching spiny stems covered in clusters of slender-stalked butter yellow flowers, Mar-April. Ht 5ft. Red fruits produced in August. Fertile well drained soil, sun.

Quercus Phellos £17.50

Deciduous, spreading tree of elegant habit. Narrow, willow like, pale green leaves turn yellow, then brown in the autumn. Thrives best in well drained soil & a sunny spot. Height 10m. Spread 15m.

Rhamnus Alat. 'Argenteovariegata' £25.00

Evergreen bushy shrub with oval glossy, leathery, grey green leaves edged with creamy-white. Yellow/green flws, May-Jun, followed by spherical red, then black fruits. May need protection in colder areas. Fertile soil, sun/ part shade. Height to 5m

Rhamnus cathartica £25.00

A deciduous native shrub or small tree. The spiny branches are quite attractive in autumn, when laden with masses of shining black fruits. Any well drained soil, sun or semi-shade.

Salix alba 'Hutschinsons Yellow' £17.50

A rare variety. Clear golden yellow stems, excellent for group planting near water. Prune hard back each year in April for best stem colour. Moist soil. Height up to 6 metres

Salix lapponum £15.00

Lapland willow. A small, densely branched shrub with grey green downy leaves. Silky grey catkins appear before the leaves in spring

Syringa 'Lark Song' £15.00

A beautiful form with large open panicles of clear rose pink flowers. Fragrant. Flws: May-June. Strong growing, bushy habit. Ht 12-15ft. Most soils, esp. chalk, sun.

Syringa pekinensis 'Yellow Fragrance' £20.00

Salix hookeriana £17.50

Coastal Willow. Glossy, reddish brown branches. Long green leaves appear with the catkins in spring. Moist soil.

Salix myrsinifolia £10.00

Dark leaved willow. Native to parts of Europe including the United Kingdom, *Salix myrsinifolia* is grown primarily for its large dark green leaves and shining, ebony coloured, bare stems which are visible throughout the winter. These winter stems are especially ornamental if this plant is pruned back hard annually in spring. In spring attractive catkins with golden anthers appear on the branches. Ht up to 13ft or 6ft if coppiced annually. Lovely when planted in groups next to ponds or streams.

Sorbus torminalis £25.00

'Wild service tree'. Ascending branches, spreading later. Sharply lobed maple like leaves, shiny green turning crimson or yellow in autumn. White flowers and russet brown oval or round fruits. Ht 16ft in 10 years.

Stachyurus praecox var. 'Matsuzakii' £25.00

A Japanese variety with larger, longer leaves. Deciduous, spreading, open shrub. Drooping spikes of yellow flws April on the bare wood. Full sun and well drained soil. Ht 5ft. Sd 8ft. Needs winter protection in coldest localities, best grown against wall.

Syringa Patula 'Miss Kim' £17.50

Forms a dense rounded bush with light green ovate foliage, cylindrical heads violet, white throated flowers, sweetly scented. May/Jun. Ht 4ft. Very hardy. Well drained soil, full sun.

Sorbus Terminalis £25.00

White peeling bark with age, slightly pendulous branches. Diamond-shaped green leaves turn yellow in Autumn. Matures into 20ft.

Salix purpurea 'Nancy Saunders' AGM £17.50

Attractive purple stemmed shoots with glaucous leaves. Catkins on bare stems in spring. Moist soil in sun. Deciduous. Ht 15ft.

Salix alba 'Hutschinsons Yellow' £17.50

A rare variety. Clear golden yellow stems, excellent for group planting near water. Prune hard back each year in April for best stem colour. Moist soil. Height up to 6 metres

Salix lapponum £15.00

Lapland willow. A small, densely branched shrub with grey green downy leaves. Silky grey catkins appear before the leaves in spring

Taxodium Distichum 'Cascade Falls' £25.00

Weeping swamp cypress. A spectacular weeping form originating from New Zealand. Best grown up a cane and allowed to weep at the desired height. Soft green spring foliage turns rich golden brown in autumn. Ht 2-3m in 10 years. Sun or part shade. Moist to well drained soil.

Taxodium Distichum 'Cascade Falls' £25.00

Weeping swamp cypress. A spectacular weeping form originating from New Zealand. Best grown up a cane and allowed to weep at the desired height. Soft green spring foliage turns rich golden brown in autumn. Ht 2-3m in 10 years. Sun or part shade. Moist to well drained soil

Taxodium Distichum 'Schloss Herten' £25.00

A dwarf variety which seems to develop an upright form with fresh green leaves. May be planted in any soil but chalky. Ideal for waterlogged sites if mound planted.

Viburnum dentatum 'Chicago lustre' (synon. Chicago Lustre) £17.50

Upright, suckering shrub with shiny green leaves. Clusters of small white flws, May followed by blue fruits. Yellow autumn colouring. Ht 8-10ft. Any reasonable soil. Sun or part shade.

Viburnum Bracteatum £20.00

A rare shrub with rounded leaves. Clusters of white flowers with conspicuous bracts, May/ June followed by bluish black fruits. Ht 6-7ft. Any reasonable soil.
